To Whom It May Concern:

This letter is being written in support of the request that the Journal of Cancer Science and Therapy (JCST) be indexed in PubMed. As a senior editor of JCST, I have been involved in the advancement and promotion of this very important and effective, peer-reviewed, international, open access journal. Since its debut in 2009 with 18 excellent scientific articles in only 2 issues, JCST boasted 113 outstanding articles in 12 monthly issues in 2012 and is presently going strong in 2013. Based on a recently determined unofficial (calculated) impact factor of 5.82, an H-Factor of 5, and an Index Copernicus Value of 5.13, JCST out ranks many well known scientific journals in the medical and oncological fields, including Molecular Cancer, the Journal of Hematology and Oncology, Radiation Oncology and the Journal of Experimental & Clinical Cancer Research, and is on par with Breast Cancer Research (presently ranked at an Impact Factor of 5.87).

The aim of JCST is to be one of the most reliable sources for current information on advances and developments in cancer science and therapies. Thus, the focus of JCST is the rapid publication of articles of scientific excellence in all areas of cancer research and therapeutic approaches. To date, Cancer Therapy and Cancer Biology have been the two most common areas of classification for articles published in JCST, but the journal promotes articles in Anti-Cancer Drugs, Tumor Immunity, Clinical Reports, Cancer Epidemiology, Cancer Genetics, Genetic Mutation and Cancer, Cancer Prevention, Hematological Malignancies, Pediatric Cancer Research, among others.

JCST, an OMIC Group Journal, is presently indexed in Index Copernicus, Scopus, CAS Division of ACS, SCIRUS, DOAJ, EBSCO Publishing, Gale (Cengag Learning), ULRICHS Web (Global Serials Directory), and others databases. Thus, as an editor of a rapidly climbing scientific journal in the field of cancer research and therapy, I strongly recommend JCST be included in PubMed indexing.
